The 2007 Pfizer/ADHA Awards for Excellence in Dental Hygiene



Pfizer Inc joins the American Dental Hygienists' Association (ADHA) in honoring dental hygienists who exemplify excellence in dental hygiene.

The award, sponsored by a grant from Pfizer Inc, will recognize individual dental hygienists who have made "outstanding accomplishments that have a significant impact on the practice and future of the dental hygiene profession." A **maximum of seven** dental hygienists will be selected for these prestigious awards. Each will receive a cash award of \$2,500 and be provided with a two-night, all expense-paid trip to the 2007 ADHA annual session in New Orleans, Louisiana. Winners will be honored at a special annual session awards luncheon on June 24, 2007.

Essay formats will be utilized—one to be completed by the nominee, and one to be completed by the nominator. The purpose of the essays will be to demonstrate evidence of advancing the professional roles of the dental hygienist. The professional roles are clinician, educator, advocate, administrator/manager, and researcher, with public health as an integral component of all these roles.

This is an opportunity to identify colleagues who have made significant contributions to the growth and development of the profession. Take this opportunity to

nominate deserving dental hygienists. If you wish to nominate more than one person, please submit each name on a separate sheet. Send nominations to:

Submissions must be received **no later than November 3, 2006**. To ensure safe and on-time delivery, express delivery services are recommended.

Nominators and nominees will be sent the appropriate essay forms for completion, which will also be available online. Additionally, the nominee will be sent a personal/professional data application. The entire packet of materials—essays from nominator, nominee, and the data application—must be received in ADHA's central office no later than January 5, 2007. Submissions not adhering to this date will be disqualified. The awards committee will recommend nominees to the board of trustees, who will select the winners by March 12, 2007. Award recipients will be notified shortly thereafter.

Criteria:

- Hold at least 10 years membership in ADHA prior to application.
- Demonstrate evidence of active involvement in ADHA and its constituents.
- Exhibit evidence of leadership in and the advancement of dental hygiene experience.
- Provide evidence of the incorporation of any and/or all of the roles to document "outstanding accomplishments that have a significant impact on the practice and future of the dental hygiene profession."

This individual award is accessible and attainable by all ADHA members. The committee members are calibrated and use an evaluation system with specific guidelines. The applicants will be provided with the specific evaluation criteria offering insight into the requisite attributes which are included in each section.

Note: Members of the ADHA Board of Trustees, ADHA staff, current members of the Pfizer/ADHA Awards committee, and past Pfizer award winners are not eligible for nomination. In addition, current members of ADHA's Board of Trustees are not eligible to nominate individuals for this award. Previous nominees are encouraged to re-apply for the award.
